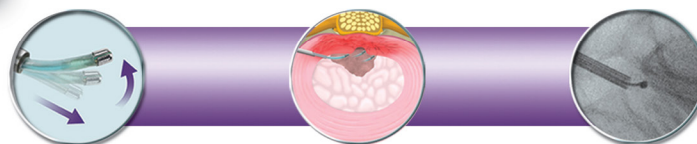
1 Nucleus Decompression/Discectomy



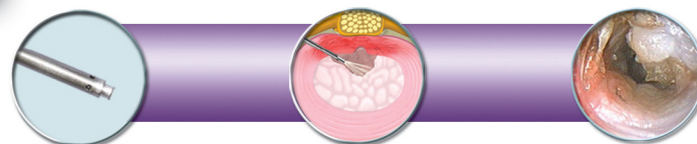
2 Nucleus Ablation
